Automated external defibrillation (AED)

While defibrillator units are very simple to operate, and no previous first aid training is required, this four-hour course gives people the confidence to act quickly and effectively in an emergency. Crucially, this course will teach your defibrillator operators how to perform effective CPR.

Course duration: Four hours

Certification: One year



First aid at work (FAW) courses do not cover the use of defibrillators.

If you decide to provide a defibrillator in your workplace, it is important that those who may use it are appropriately trained.



Your AED Shelf life

Your AED battery and pads have shelf lives. It's important to know when to replenish these so you never have a possibility of it not working when you need it most.



Recycling your old batteries

It is recommended that all batteries are disposed of safely (not in household waste); most local supermarkets have a used battery collection point. Or contact your local council for advice on the safe disposal of used batteries in your area.
